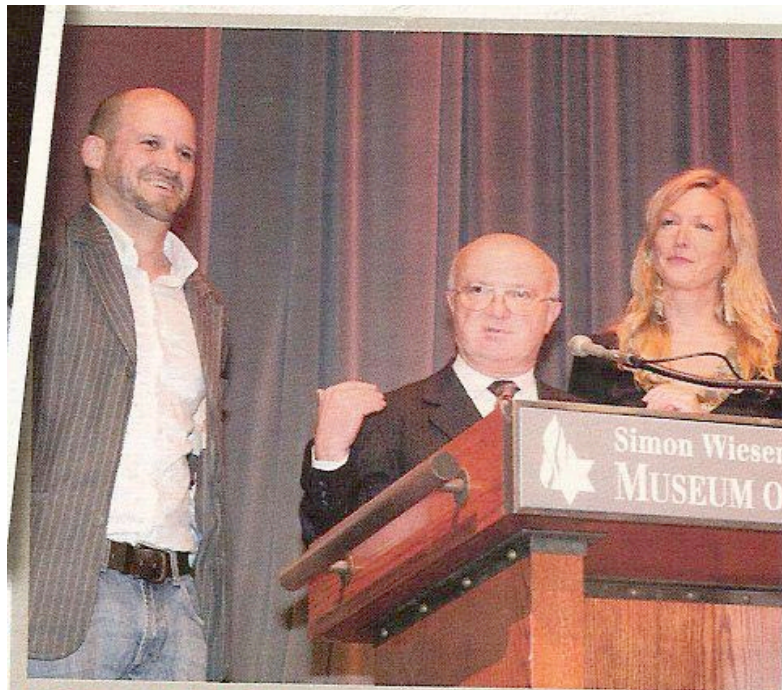

# HONOUR FOR FREEDOM DOC

At a screening of their documentary *Freedom's Fury* in Los Angeles last week, directors Colin Keith Gray (pictured above, left) and Megan Raney Aarons (above, right) were awarded the Knight's Cross Order of the Republic Of Hungary. The award was presented by Hungarian consulate general Ferenc Bosenbacher. The screening was held two days after the 50th anniversary of the start of the Hungarian Revolution. The film looks at the revolution and the bloody water polo match between Hungary and the Soviets at the Melbourne Olympics that same month, events which also inspired the feature film *Children Of Glory*, currently on release in Hungary. Also attending the screening were cinematographers Joseph Miko and Vilmos Zsigmond who shot footage of the revolution with Laszlo Kovacs. Another attendee was Olympic gold medallist swimmer Mark Spitz, who narrated the documentary.
